

PRINTING NOTES:

You will need **1 FAMILY NOTES FOLDER PER TABLE.**

Each Folder will need:

- **Page 2**—1 copy: Cover can be printed on full sheet labels or on regular paper which can then be glued to the front, depending on what your facility allows.
 - Click link or search Amazon for [Full Sheet Address Shipping Labels - 8-1/2" x 11" - 100 Labels](#) (price as of July 2019—\$10.99)
- **Page 3**—8 copies: 1 each for Talks 1-8. The “Secretary” will use these to make a summary of the family discussion following each talk.
- **Page 4**—1 copy: This is the FAMILY SUMMARY of the closing questions to be read during closing
- **Page 5**—6 copies or 1 copy per star for each table.

MISC. NOTES:

- If the facility allows, print each type of form on different colored paper. (It will make it easier to distinguish between the family and individual summaries, plus make it more appealing to the Stars.)
- The blank line above “Family” on the cover is for the family to write in their name once it’s been chosen. (ex. “The Kindness Family Notes”)
- Use this folder to keep Talk Summaries and Closing Summaries together. Talk summaries are shared at the end of DAY 1 when the Stars present their Creative Expressions of each talk. The family’s Closing Questions Summary is shared during the Closing Ceremony on Day 3.
- Optional: You may also choose to use this folder to keep the blank activity sheets in for each talk. It can be helpful to wait until after a talk is finished to pass out activity sheets so that Stars are less distracted during the talk. Stars can use plain notebook paper to take their own notes on during a talk. Activity sheets can then be passed out and used to help facilitate discussion. (Some facilities place the activity sheets in the ATL’s folder.)
